Cooking with Neelix



Slow Cooker Hamburger Stew

2 pounds russet potatoes, peeled and diced into 1-inch cubes

1/2 pound carrots, peeled and sliced

1 yellow onion, diced

2 cloves garlic, minced

1/2 teaspoon dried rosemary

1/4 teaspoon black pepper, freshly cracked

1/2 teaspoon dried thyme

1 pound ground beef

1 (15 ounce) can stewed tomatoes

2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

2 cups beef broth

1 tablespoon soy sauce

1 cup frozen peas



Add the potatoes, carrots, onion, garlic, rosemary, pepper, and thyme to a slow cooker. In a skillet over medium heat on the stove-top, brown the ground beef and drain the excess fat.

Add the drained and browned beef to the slow cooker along with the can of stewed tomatoes, including the juices.

Add the Worcestershire sauce, beef broth, and soy sauce to the slow cooker. Stir the contents of the slow cooker briefly to evenly combine the ingredients.

Place the lid on the slow cooker and cook on high heat for 4 hours, or on low heat for 8 hours.

After cooking, remove the lid and stir the stew.

Use the back of the spoon to mash the potatoes to thicken the stew.

Add in the frozen peas and stir to combine.



DEEP SPACE NINE REMEMBERING Estelle Louise Fletcher July 22, 1934 September 23, 2022



Star Trek fans know Fletcher for her recurring role of Winn Adami, appearing 14 times over seven seasons of *Star Trek: Deep Space Nine*. The Bajoran Vedek who rose to Kai often came into conflict with Benjamin Sisko and Kira Nerys, making her one of the franchise's <u>best-known adversaries</u>. Fletcher was nominated for five (and won four) awards from the Online Film & Television Association for her work on *Deep Space Nine*.

SEPTEMBER 21, 2022 - She was known for her film, television, Broadway, and music recording work. She also managed to stop by for a couple of episodes of *Star Trek*. Deadline is reporting on a life and career ended too soon, as Marva Hicks died, on September 16. While it has been an open question, her Wikipedia page indicates she was 66.

Star Trek fans will know her as Tuvok's wife in the Star Trek: Voyager season two episode, "Persistence of Vision" and the seventh season episode, "Body and Soul."

Outside of *Star Trek*, Hicks made her Broadway debut in *Lena Horne: The Lady and Her Music*, in 1981, and most recently appeared in 2013's *Motown: The Musical*. She also made appearances in non-Broadway stage productions as well as film and television roles, including in *L.A. Law, Babylon 5*, and *House of Cards*.

Hallmark Gives Mirror Universe Scotty the Holiday Treatment



SEPTEMBER 20, 2022 - It's been three years in the making, but we are now closing in on completing the series of Mirror Universe Keepsake ornaments from Hallmark, which was previewed earlier this year.

First up of the last two Storyteller ornaments is Lt. Montgomery Scott, and <u>TrekCore has a review</u>. The Scotty ornament follows up Kirk, Sulu, and Uhura, which were released in 2020, and Spock and Chekov, released in 2021. Scotty is wearing a dagger, phaser, and, of course, a gold sash, and he is striking a contemplative pose.

Each of the character ornaments contains audio from the episode and will play back lines from the episode on their own — but when brought together, the ornaments will communicate with each other with built-in radio technology to replicate scenes from the episode where those characters interacted. Lights and audio require the separately purchased Keepsake Power Cord.

Scotty and the rest of the Storyteller ornaments are available to order now, and the last ornament in the series, Dr. Leonard McCoy, is due out in October.

NASA spacecraft buzzes Jupiter moon Europa, closest in years

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP) — NASA's Juno spacecraft has made the closest approach to Jupiter's tantalizing, icy moon Europa in more than 20 years.

Juno on Thursday zipped within approximately 219 miles (352 kilometers) of Europa, thought to have an ocean flowing beneath its thick frozen crust, raising the possibility of underwater life. Scientists hailed the flyby as a success, with four pictures beamed down and released within several hours.


Scientists had hoped to observe possible water plumes shooting from the surface of Europa, close in size to Earth's moon. But none were immediately visible in the initial look.

"We have to be at the right place at just the right time," Juno's chief scientist, Scott Bolton of Southwest Research Institute in San Antonio, said in a statement.

John Bordi, deputy mission manager at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, expected the spacecraft to go "screaming by pretty fast," with a relative velocity of almost 15 miles per second (23.6 kilometers per second).

The first photo from the flyby is a closeup of Europa's equatorial region, crisscrossed by ridges, troughs and possibly an impact crater.

The latest observations will help NASA plan for its Europa Clipper mission, due to launch in 2024 and arrive at the Jovian system in 2030. The European Space Agency also plans close encounters with its Jupiter Icy Moons Explorer, or Juice, lifting off next year.
