

I was born in 1983. As a result, my introduction to Star Trek came in the form of Star Trek: The Next Generation. From the age of four through eleven, it was one of the shows that was regularly on the TV. In the form of reruns, I was able to become rather familiar with much of what I was originally too young to understand or pay attention to.

Wesley Crusher, though wildly unpopular with much of the fandom, stood out as being rather special to me. I wasn't the healthiest of children. Even though I took martial arts classes and did get to play outside from time-to-time, much of my time was spent in books and watching TV and movies. This resulted in my being a child that didn't quite fit with others in my age bracket. So, for me, Wesley was a great analog into that world.

That's why the TNG episode, "Journey's End" (S7 Ep20), struck home. Nearly ten years after its original air date, an obscure episode with a character that many dislike, suddenly had a deeper meaning. I was in that place that Wesley was. Doing

what I thought I wanted to do, living up to the expectations of others, and trying to figure out why I was so dissatisfied with it all. That one episode encompassed everything I was feeling. It even helped me be able to drop what I was doing and live in the mo-

ment for what seemed like the first time ever.

This is the power of Star Trek. Often the discussions of Star Trek's contributions stop with the more general technology, optimism for the future, and inspiration to explore the stars. These are all true and of the utmost importance. However, the personal impact that this franchise has had on its viewers should never be overlooked. Now, I find myself relating to different characters and being comforted with the familiarity of the old shows while being entertained by the new. But I believe that there will never be a time where Trek will be irrelevant in either the micro or the macro.
