

BUTTERSCOTCH-GINGER COOKIES

INGREDIENTS:

½ c. butter, softened
 ½ c. brown sugar (packed)
 1 egg
 1 ½ c. flour
 one 3 ½ oz package cook & serve butterscotch pudding mix
 1 ½ tsp. ground ginger
 ½ tsp. cinnamon
 ½ tsp. baking powder
 ½ c. butterscotch chips

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
 Using mixer with large bowl: cream butter, brown sugar, and egg
 In a separate bowl, whisk together: flour, pudding mix, ginger, baking powder and cinnamon
 Gradually stir flour mixture into butter/sugar/egg mixture and mix until well combined.
 Stir in butterscotch chips.
 Shape dough into teaspoon size balls & place on ungreased baking sheets.
 Leave at least 2" of space between the dough balls, as they will spread out! Bake 10 minutes.




Over the sand dunes and through the scrub



Guy – Just routine, except at Wakanda movie the guy in front of him got irate when Guy tapped his seat because he was using his phone.



From the Chaplain

Getting Dressed

I've recently been researching the uniforms of the Federation for a project with the Starfleet Chaplain Corps (a separate fan group from FSI). While looking for sources, I stumbled across TriAngulum Audio Studios' "Trek Facts" series. There was a four-part video series discussing the topic of uniforms, though they were made before the late third and fourth season of Discovery saw a transition of styles. They were, nevertheless, an interesting take on the subject that looked at it from the frame narrative rather than the real world prospective.

The stance that the video took on the reasons for the frequent change in style was that the changes were made to meet the needs of the moment. The goal was to balance the utility with comfort and to express the tone of the Federation's role in the greater universe. The uniform helped to manage the first impression on others as well as the mindset of the person in the uniform. This later point is part of how the uniform builds conformity, but it also is part of how it builds unity and comradery. At this point the uniform becomes a symbol of the work done to earn the privilege of wearing it and the shared purpose of the values it embodies.

An unexpected thing happened in the course of researching something as minor as a guide to help build a costume for a non-canon part of a fictional organization. I started thinking about how I represent myself. In this country, our right to self-expression is a baked in feature. It is also a privilege

shared by any in the free world. And then the sad truth of the expression, "Free World" sunk in. It implies the existence of an unfree world. That drove in the point that our freedom to be who we are is something we should be thankful for. And that gratitude is best expressed in action; the action of putting on our best selves.

Now, just what our best self is, is a matter of conjecture. It is something that we each must decide for ourselves. It must be a matter of putting forth our own standards and trying to live up to them. Just as the uniforms of Starfleet changed as an expression of what ideals it wanted to present, we must carry ourselves in a manner that matches our evolving ideals in our daily lives. We may not always be up to the standards we have set for ourselves. Such is the nature of sentient beings. But as cadets strive to earn their right to wear the full uniform, we can strive to grow and meet those standards. Because growth is also part of our nature as sentients. May we all continue to grow and meet the needs of the day. May we also continue to grow to meet the needs of the future.
