

On Joy

Some days there appear to be little of joy. Seems that the political strife is rising, people oftentimes are more unfriendly, bad things seem to be a daily occurrence. Well, a little joy, even a spark of it can help reduce chronic illness, making your immune system a bit better, and strengthen your reserves!

“Unlike other emotions, you can prepare more for it!” So says Dr. Philip C. Watkins, a psychologist at Eastern Washington University. “The best joy is probably most generally experienced in relationships.” Meaningful goals and purpose is also essential.

So, here are some suggestions to achieve small amounts of joy every day, no matter what’s happening:

1. WRITE A JOY BUCKET LIST

There are inevitable times when it appears everything might seem to be spiraling out of control. Robin Shear, a life coach in Detroit, turns to her “joy bucket list,” a tally of all things that make her happy: test-driving fast cars or sharing new experiences with her family. Make your list and store it in a very accessible space.

2. MAKE DAILY NEW HABITS YOU LOOK FORWARD TO

It could be as simple as coffee or tea in a colorful mug. “Joy is a multisensory,” says Dr. Cohen, a sociology professor at the University South Carolina, Beaufort. Think about ways to schedule pleasurable habits into your day. Then savor the an-

ticipation of them, because that’s part of the joy.

3. FIND PALATABLE WAYS TO EXPRESS GRATITUDE

Gratitude fuels well-being, research has shown. Think about creative ways to reflect on and appreciate the good parts of your life – Find one small thing that’s good about every day, even on the bad days.

4. LOOK FOR CONNECTION

Nora McInerny, host of the podcast “Terrible, Thanks for Asking,” gets lost in gloominess and seeks connection such as a call to a loved or dearly loved friend. Even catching someone’s eye and maybe a brief smile can be enough/”

5. TAKE A SHORT “RECESS”

Small amounts of physical activity can elevate your mood and cut risk of depression. Robin Shear says maybe schedule a five - or 10-minute play session – hula hooping, “dance-march” once or twice a day. Maybe set a fun ring tone of your phone alarm to remind you it’s time.

6. DANCE IT OUT

Music is a reliable way to spark a few minutes of joy, according to Melanie Horth, a psychologist based in Santa Fe, NM. Create a happiness playlist full of fun upbeat music.

Berry Orange Jello Salad

* Two large boxes strawberry jello. I used the 4 ounce Starburst strawberry flavor, which is pink.



- * Two 15-ounce cans mandarin oranges.
- * 2 cups total strawberries and blueberries diced in small pieces.
- * 1 1/2 cups mini marshmallows.

Note: this quantity is for potluck size, I doubled up how much I would normally make.

Each large jello package calls for 1 1/2 cups boiling water and 1 1/2 cups cold water. Use boiling water and dissolve the gelatin as usual ... but!

For the cold water step, save the liquid from the canned oranges, and then add cold water to that for a total 1 cup cold liquid per package. The orange liquid adds the extra flavor.

Basic formula: I cut the cold water amounts by 1/3. This modification keeps fruity jello from getting too runny.

Stir the dissolved gelatin, liquid and oranges and other fruit in the serving bowl or jello mold you plan to chill it in.

Dump in the marshmallows and stir again. They will float to top after melting a bit. The fruit will float around and settle to bottom and middle.

Put the serving bowl in fridge. It will take about four hours to set, so do the prep a day ahead or early morning before serving.

My potluck dish where I brought the jello salad is a Pyrex casserole carrier that came with both hot pad and freezer pad pockets. That particular one is no longer made, but there are others on the market.





Relationships

While working my way through *Star Trek: Deep Space Nine*, I have been reminded many times over why it is my personal favorite iteration in the franchise. One of the more fascinating aspects of it is that in this installation in the franchise we see a three generational relationship in the Siskos. This is unique in the Trek universe. Many of the other characters in the franchise have less than ideal relationships with their parents and/or children.

What makes this even more impressive is that the strong connection is through the male line. It has been an unlikeable trend in film and literature to propagate the idea of strained relationships between men in general and even more so between men in a family line. Television has been getting better about showing healthy relationships between fathers and their children. However, at the time of *Deep Space Nine's* release, many drama-based shows and movies were using strained relationships as character building. The sad truth is that it is believable because in many cases it is the same as in real life.

We live in a world where there is a special emphasis on the relationships we build with others; often outside of our family. The term applied is "family we choose". These relationships are infinitely meaningful and well worth maintaining. However, this world also tells us that it is perfectly valid to sever relationships that cause us harm. This point is not without merit. There are many people that we will come into contact with that, for whatever reason, will cause us harm.

What we are not told is where the line between disagreements and irreconcilable differences is. We are not educated as to the point at which harmful behavior begins. Forgiveness is always something

that is urged, as grudges do more to harm the one holding them than whom they are held against. But there is at no point an explanation given as to when reconciliation between the parties is unadvisable. We are left to find all of this out on our own.

How do we learn this? Trial and error are effective means of learning but are far from the preferred method in matters of the heart. The best way is by seeing what a healthy relationship looks like. In the characters of the Siskos, Joseph, Benjamin, and Jake, we see just that. Joseph wanted his son to be a chef and keep the family restaurant going. Benjamin chose life in Starfleet. That decision led to many disagreements, especially during the Dominion infiltration of the Federation. Yet, the two were able to talk about their differences and grow through them. Then, Benjamin had expected Jake to follow in his footsteps. Jake chose writing. Benjamin was supportive, and yet there were moments of friction. Just as with he and his father, Benjamin worked through his differences with his son.

At the same time, Benjamin was regularly put into situations requiring him to work with Dukat. No matter how much service he was at times, no matter what they had to go through together, Benjamin never became more than an acquaintance. He knew that there could be no friendship or even respect. However, that didn't allow him to hold enough of a grudge to treat Dukat's daughter poorly.

It is an unfortunate truth that not all of us are blessed to have that type of example in our lives. But we can look at this example and see what we can take from it. We can ask ourselves; "How can this inform our relationships with others?", "Are we letting little disagreements get in the way of something great?" "Are we allowing momentary commiseration to blind us to genuinely toxic behavior?", "Are we letting our injuries at the hands of another cause us to hurt those who didn't hurt us?" We must ask ourselves questions like these regularly to ensure that it is the healthiest relationships possible that are being kept in our lives. May we all have lives filled with great friends and loving family.

GLISTENING STAR CLUSTERS

The densely packed globular cluster NGC 6325 glistens in this image from the NASA/ESA [Hubble Space Telescope](#). This concentrated group of stars lies around 26,000 light-years from Earth in the constellation Ophiuchus.



Globular clusters like NGC 6325 are tightly bound collections of stars with anywhere from tens of thousands to millions of members. They can be found in all types of galaxies and act as natural laboratories for astronomers studying star formation. This is because the constituent stars of globular clusters tend to form at roughly the same time and with similar initial composition, meaning astronomers can use them to fine-tune their theories of how stars evolve.

Astronomers inspected this particular cluster not to understand star formation, but to search for a hidden monster. Though it might look peaceful, astronomers suspect this cluster could contain an intermediate-mass black hole that is subtly affecting the motion of surrounding stars. Previous research found that the distribution of stars in some highly concentrated globular clusters – those with stars packed relatively tightly together – was slightly different from what astronomers expected.
