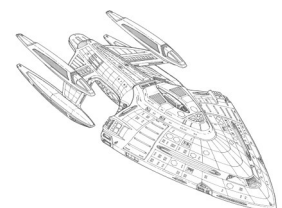

- .5 oz White Creme de Cocoa
- .5 oz Irish Cream
- .5 oz Butterscotch Schnapps
- .5 oz ~~Goldschlager~~



Pour all ingredients and ice into a shaker cup, shake, strain into a shot [glass](#) and enjoy.
