

immersive tabletop game allows players to step into the shoes of Starfleet commanders, leading their own landing parties on daring missions across the galaxy.




### Three Star Trek Novels Are Nominated for Scribe Awards



This year the seventeenth annual Scribes include nominations for three *Star Trek* novels.

Jonathan Mayberry, president of IAMTW, announced the nominations on his Goodreads blog. Among the nominations are *Harm's Way* by David Mack (*Original Series*) and *High Country* by John Jackson Miller (*Strange New Worlds*). Both titles are vying for the award in the Best Original Novel – Speculative category. The third nomination appears in the Best Young Adult / Middle Grade category, *A Dangerous Trade* by Cassandra Rose Clarke (*Prodigy*).

Star Trek: Picard brought back familiar faces from Star Trek: The Next Generation. It was meant to be a reunion and farewell to the old cast, but viewers were surprised that the series had brought Jeri Ryan back to Star Trek. Jeri Ryan, aka Seven of Nine, had walked away from the franchise years ago at the end of Star Trek: Voyager.

There have been rumors going around that the actress was also going to be starring in the film *Star Trek: Nemesis*, but she never did. According to Jeri Ryan, she didn't want to be "type-cast" and thus went on to doing a different series, *Boston Public*, and leaving the franchise.

Her return to *Star Trek* would be around two decades later. Reading about what Jeri Ryan did those years, many have wondered what her character Seven of Nine has been doing those past years and soon, you'll find out in a new novel, which will take place during *Star Trek: Picard*.

After Star Trek: Voyager's ending and their return to the Alpha Quadrant, Star Trek Picard - Firewall will feature Seven of Nine and it will be released on February 27th, 2024.

### Jonathan Frakes on the Possibility of Star Trek: Legacy

Star Trek series alum and director <u>Jonathan Frakes</u> has spoken about the possibility of getting executive producer Terry Matalas' proposed sequel series **Star Trek: Legacy** made.

While speaking with <u>Variety</u>, Frakes noted that the recent final season of <u>Star Trek: Picard</u> was well-received and said that, as an optimist, he believes Star Trek: Legacy could come to fruition.

"I think they can't deny not only the fan reaction, but the fact that the numbers put the show at the Top 10 on the streaming charts," Frakes stated. "And that season of Star Trek: Picard was arguably the among the best seasons of any Star Trek — I think we all agree on that. I mean, Star Trek fans are loyal. It's not millions and millions of people, and it's not the youngest fandom in the world. But I am an eternal optimist, and I believe in a perfect world, they will find the assets and the energy and hire Terry to put together this Legacy show and that will, in fact, come to fruition."

What is Star Trek: Legacy?

Star Trek: Legacy is a potential sequel series to Star Trek: Picard that was pitched on social media by executive producer Terry Matalas. It would see Captain Seven of Nine in command of the U.S.S. Enterprise-G alongside Jack Crusher — Picard's son, who is embarking on his assignment in the field.

Matales has insisted that there are currently no plans to develop Star Trek: Legacy, noting that Paramount has enough series in the works as it is.

### **Cooking with Neelix**

### **Amish Macaroni Salad**



2 cups elbow macaroni

3 hard-boiled eggs, chopped

1 small onion, chopped

3 celery stalks, chopped

1 small red bell pepper, chopped

2 tablespoons dill pickle relish

2 cups creamy salad dressing, such as Miracle Whip®

3 tablespoons prepared yellow mustard

3/4 cup white sugar

2 1/4 teaspoons white vinegar

1/4 teaspoon salt

3/4 teaspoon celery seed



In a large pot of salted, boiling water, cook the macaroni to al dente, according to the package directions.

Set the macaroni aside to cool.

In a large bowl, combine the hard-boiled eggs, the onion, the celery, the red bell pepper, and the dill pickle relish.

In another bowl, mix the creamy salad dressing, the yellow mustard, the white sugar, the white vinegar, the salt, and the celery seed together.

Pour the dressing mixture over the veggie mixture.

Add the macaroni to the veggie mixture and mix well until combined.

Cover the bowl and refrigerate for at least 1 hour and up to overnight. Serve chilled.

### **Growing Plants in Space**




N E W Crew members aboard the International Space Station conducted a variety of scientific investigations during the week of July 10, 2023, including setting up and initiating a round of operations for **Plant Habitat-03**.

This investigation assesses whether epigenetic adaptations in a generation of *Arabadopsis thaliana* plants grown in space can transfer to the next generation. Adding extra information to genetic material (DNA) rather than changing existing information is an example of an epigenetic adaptation. Determining whether plants pass these changes on to subsequent generations could identify genetic elements that increase the adaptability of plants to spaceflight.


