

Mosquito: ANOPHELES SP. (Species)

They are small, their wing length is only 3 mm. Their FAMILY is Culicidae, which has about 3,000 (yes, 3,000) species, 150 of which live in North America. Their habi-

tat varies, but they prefer being around water – lakes to marshes to pools. Mostly found in tropical and subtropical climes, but some temperate areas, also!

Malaria is the most widespread and well-known disease carried by mosquitoes. Our first president George Washington and first lady Martha suffered from bouts of it.

It appears that it has been around just about forever as it has been discovered in mosquitoes preserved in amber.

Mosquitoes love carbon dioxide, lactic acid, and octonel, which are found in human sweat and breath. They also sense heat and humidity of the body. Dark colors and beer are also attractive to them.

41% of the world's population live in areas where malaria is easily caught, 500 million cases worldwide. Most of

those who die are young children in sub-Saharan Africa. Controlling malaria costs up to \$3 billion. Bed nets are extremely important since nighttime is mosquitoes' favorite time for activity. October 2021 saw some of the first vaccines to appear and be working. Testing continues.

Instant Pot Cranberry Sauce Submitted by Linda Fotoples

Recipe by Rmy * Jacky | PressureCookRecipes.com

Servings – 4-6 Total Time: 20 minutes Instant Pot – longer on stove top

INGREDIENTS

12 oz bag of cranberries about 3 cups
2 ½ teaspoons orange zest – from a large orange
¼ cup orange juice squeezed from your large orange
2 Tablespoons maple syrup or honey
A pinch of salt
About ½ cup white sugar, add more to taste if needed

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Wash cranberries**: Remove stems, soft, discolored or wrinkly ones. Rinse berries under cold running water.
- Pressure cook cranberries: Combine 2 Tablespoons maple syrup or honey with ¼ cup orange juice, then pour in the Pot. Add 2 ½ teaspoons orange zest and the cranberries in the Pot.
- 3. Close lid, make sure Venting Knob is at Sealing position.
- Pressure cook at high Manual for 1 minute. Allow 7 minutes Natural Release.
- 5. Open lid carefully.

- Make Sauce Press Cancel, then press Saute button. Stir and break the cranberrries with a wooden spoon. Add ½ cup white sugar and stir. The heat will instantly dissolve the sugar. Add a pinch of salt.
- Taste carefully adjust by adding more sugar if needed.
 You can add a little hot water if it's too thick.
- **StoveTop directions by feelgoodfoodie.net/recipe/cranberry
 -orange-sauce/
- Place cranberries, sugar, orange zest, orange juice and ½ cup water in a saucepan.
- 2. **Cook** on medium-high. The mixture will bubble. Stir.
- Continue cooking until most of the berries burst, most of the liquid is absorbed, and sauce has thickened. Taste carefully to adjust sweetness.
- 4. **Transfer** sauce to a heatresistant glass bowl and let sit on counter until it cools.



5. It's ready to be served or stored in the fridge until served.

I Make No Excuse

"Excuse: a reason or explanation put forward to defend or justify a fault or offense." -Oxford Languages-

Within the Trek universe, the recurring theme of action and consequence is sometimes overlooked. Many times, it can seem like the plot armor on hero characters defends them not only from death and/or injury, not only guarantees them the win, but also protects them from the ramifications of their actions.

In *The Original Series*, Spock commits mutiny, and it results only in the guise of a court-martial and Starfleet relaxing its quarantine on Talos IV. This starts a long line of events in all subsequent series where rules are subverted and even blatantly ignored. There are times where even the Prime Directive is regarded as the "Prime Suggestion." Captain Sisko goes so far as to manufacture evidence, provide the means and opportunity for an assassination, and manipulate a government to aid in a war that nearly resulted in genocide. His punishment? None. Starfleet signed off on the idea.

However, with a closer look, we can see that there are moments when even the illustrious Kirk must answer for his actions and be busted from a Rear Admiral back to Captain. The truth is that Starfleet accepts no excuses and yet understands mitigating circumstances.

Some years back, I became a Knight in The Fraternal Order of the Golden Owl. (For those who have wondered what the

"KGO" after my name was, here it is.) As an organization, it promotes a shared way of life in tune with the ideals of chivalric behavior. Such behavior is defined by the Creed of this said order:

"I Defend the Weak.

I Speak only Truth.

I Make no Excuse.

I Let Believe.

I Hold my Temper.

I Live with Honor.

I Make Valor my Lifelong Pursuit."

Such a code of conduct is one that has made my life interesting, to say the least. However, it has also been a challenge to uphold these standards as part of the daily grind. Making no excuse is one that has held up many a candidate for knighthood in this organization. Simply put, it can be scary to look someone in the eye and admit your mistakes and accept the consequences without complaint. But it is an action like this that shows the maturity required by each member of Starfleet.

In the daily world, a place where leadership can be imperfect and circumstances make principles hard to uphold, most learn as children how to try and weasel their way out of things. A little lie, an exaggerated situation, or a story so drawn out that the authority holding us responsible quits caring, and boom; we're free to go on merrily as we were. But the notion of integrity calls us to do better. It calls us to "make no excuse."

This does not, however, require us to not defend ourselves

when faults and offenses are erroneously or maliciously credited to us. As mentioned above, leadership can be imperfect; circumstances can be contrary to our intentions. It is then that we must choose to champion the truth.

In most cases, once the truth is known, the events that follow will be undertaken in that light. But there are occasions when we are cut off with phrases like, "I don't want to hear excuses." Or just dismissed outright once the accusations are made. These times are complicated and to pretend that they are not does a disservice to those living them.

In these moments, it is important not to disrupt the essential activities being performed, or to allow anger to make us say or do things that we will regret later. However, respectful communications should be exchanged with the appropriate people at the next opportunity. To ignore these moments in the name of "peace" will inadvertently promote the continuation of such behavior in the leadership. This in turn will lead to others being put in similar situations. To uphold the truth is important not only to us, but for others as well.

Therefore, legitimate organizations allow for the defense of the members. They are given a time to defend their actions in the face of perceived faults or offences. It is a greater disservice to precedence to not uphold the truth than it is to "rock the boat." Additionally, maintaining the truth upholds the integrity of the organization. All of the officers in the history of *Star Trek* that have been given second chances, acted in their understanding of what is best for the Federation, or the people affected by their actions. They pled their cases and accepted the consequences with dignity. Moreover, they made no excuses.
